Remember What Do You See?

- 2. **Ask,** "What do you see in this picture?" *Group* answers.
- 3. **Repeat** steps 1-2 for Story Cards 2-5.

How To Wrap Up


Talk





Remember What's Missing?

- 2. **Ask,** "Which picture is missing?" *Group answers.*
- 3. Lay Story Card in place.
- 4. **Repeat** steps 1-3, but **leave out** different card.
